James Satterwhite was born in Georgia in Columbia County on February 4, 1792

Elizabeth Manning Satterwhite daughter of Adam Manning and Mary Willingham Manning: and future wife of James was born on September 1, 1792

James married Elizabeth Manning Satterwhite in Georgia in Columbia County on February 18, 1812

James served in the War of 1812

James and Elizabeth Manning Satterwhite had their first child Mary Satterwhite on December 25, 1812

Mary Satterwhite daughter of James died in September of 1814

James and Elizabeth Manning Satterwhite had their second child Isaac Satterwhite in Georgia in Harris County on February 7, 1815

James and Elizabeth Manning Satterwhite had their third child Nancy D. Satterwhite Daniel in Georgia on March 18, 1817

Thomas Daniel future son-in-law of James was born in North Carolina on July 3, 1818

Letitia Lucy C. Hollis Satterwhite future daughter-in-law of James was born on February 12, 1819

James and Elizabeth Manning Satterwhite had their fourth child Martha Satterwhite on March 19, 1819

John George Collins brother of Seaborn Key Collins who married Elizabeth Satterwhite: and future son-in-law of James was born in 1820

Joseph Newton Scarbrough future son-in-law of James was born in Stone Mountain, Georgia in DeKalb County on September 21, 1820

James and Elizabeth Manning Satterwhite had their fifth child Penelope Satterwhite Scarbrough in Georgia in Harris County on November 1, 1823

David Satterwhite is mentioned along with his son James in Adam Manning's will in Georgia in Putman County in 1824

Arrena Rennie Parker Satterwhite future daughter-in-law of James was born in Georgia in Harris County on November 4, 1832

James is listed as being a purchaser at Samuel Hamblet's estate sale in Troup County, Georgia February 12, 1833

Rebecca Willingham Satterwhite mother of James died in Georgia in Troup County after 1840

Rebecca Satterwhite Collins daughter of James married John George Collins in Georgia in Harris County on August 5, 1843

James owned land in Alabama Sometime in 1845 – 1850

James lived in Florida six to eight months during that time

John Satterwhite son of James died on September 11, 1849

David Mitchell Satterwhite son of James married Arrena Rennie Parker Satterwhite Georgia in Harris County on December 27, 1849
